ATLANTANS CELEBRATED 2014 WITH A STAR-STUDDED NIGHT, AN 800-POUND PEACH AND A SURPRISE TWIST

More than 175,000 Patrons Gathered Downtown on New Year's Eve for the 25th Annual Peach Drop

ATLANTA – Commemorating more than two decades as the largest New Year's Eve celebration in the southeast, the 25th Annual Peach Drop, powered by M&M's Peanut, was full of excitement, star-power and new surprises. Grammy-nominated **Janelle Monáe** headlined the event and took the stage to perform her hit R&B tracks, while "Anchorman 2" comedian **David Koechner** served as the emcee for the evening, lighting up the stage with his engaging personality. Opening for Monáe on the main stage were **VEDO**, **Brian Collins**, **Sol Junky** and **Sonia Leigh**.

As the clock struck midnight, the beloved 800-pound peach began its 25th descent from 138 feet in the air. Following the drop, a fireworks show illuminated the sky above the crowd at Underground Atlanta as confetti rained down on attendees. This year's drop was accompanied by an M&M's Peanut, affixed to the top of the tower, which opened after the peach dropped, kicking off M&M's "Year of the Peanut." The all-day event also featured fun for families and kid's, including carnival rides and activities from LegoLand Discovery Center Atlanta, Atlanta Hawks and Liberty Tax Service, festival food and live music on multiple stages.

"Underground Atlanta is proud to commemorate this huge milestone as the Peach Drop celebrates 25 years as a world-renowned event and an Atlanta staple," said Dan O'Leary, President and CEO of O'LEARY Partner's, Inc. "Since the inaugural Peach Drop in 1989, we have watched our event transform into one of the city's most beloved traditions and it's truly remarkable to see how the people of Atlanta cherish this New Year's Eve celebration."

As 2013 drew to a close, Underground Atlanta kept the party rocking through the night. After crowds toasted to the New Year, many kept the party going in Kenny's Alley until early Wednesday morning.
